

## Alaska - Yukon

June 07 – 28, 2025 Depart SK

**June 07**      **Saskatoon/Regina, SK to Brooks, AB**

Boarding our luxury motor coach, we begin our journey to Canada's Yukon and Alaska.

**June 08**      **Edmonton, AB (B)**

Alberta passengers join the tour today as we travel on to Edmonton for the night.

**June 09**      **Dawson Creek, BC (B)**

Travelling in to “Big Game Country, we continue to Dawson Creek. Here we see **Milepost “0” of the Alaska Highway** and stop at the **Visitor Centre**. On route we will stop in Mayerthorpe at the **Fallen Four Memorial**.

**June 10**      **Muncho Lake, BC (B, D)**

We begin our trek on the **Alaska Highway** and learn of the rich history of this scenic route. Surrounded by the beauty of Northern BC, **Muncho Lake** is our destination. Our lodging is situated on the shores of this beautiful mountain lake.

**June 11, 12**      **Whitehorse, YT – 2 Nights (B x 2, L)**

A stop is planned at **Liard Hot Springs** for a dip in the crystalline waters of this natural pool. Yukon's territorial capital – Whitehorse, is our host for two nights. Local touring includes a visit to see the aqua waters of **Miles Canyon** and a stop at the **SS Klondike NHS**. Enjoy free time to choose from several area shops and attractions.

**June 13, 14**      **Dawson City, YT – 2 Nights (B x 2, L)**

We continue north along the banks of the Yukon River where we view **Five Finger Rapids** and enjoy an **included picnic lunch**. We **tour the "gold rush" city** visiting **Gold Dredge #4 and Discovery Claim National Historic Sites**. Visit the many historic sites, including the Robert Service Cabin, on a **free afternoon**. Be sure to not miss **Diamond Tooth Gerties**, the historic gaming and entertainment hall.

**June 15, 16**      **Fairbanks, AK – 2 Nights (B x 2, D)**

Welcome to Alaska and the **"Top of the World" Highway**. Travelling along the spine of the mountains affords breathtaking views. **Chicken**, the **Alaska Pipeline** and **Santa Claus House** are points of interest. In Fairbanks, we cruise aboard the **Riverboat**

**Discovery** learning of the local indigenous culture. Tonight, we enjoy a mouth-watering **Salmon Bake** at **Alaskaland**.

**June 17, 18, 19**      **Anchorage, AK – 3 Nights (B x 3, L, D)**

View spectacular scenery as we travel the George Parks Highway in hopes of seeing North America's tallest peak - **Mt. McKinley** towering 20,320 feet. One day we travel to Seward for a **cruise on the Kenai Fjords**. **Wildlife** and **glaciers** are guaranteed while sailing on a modern tour vessel to spot Humpback Whales, Orcas, and the glaciers dotting the coastline. A **free day** is planned to explore the shops, services and galleries of downtown.

**June 20**      **Tok, AK (B)**

This morning, we travel into the **Matanuska Valley** and stop at the **Musk Ox Farm**. Learn about these prehistoric ice age survivors and their unique role in Native Alaskan culture. We continue to Tok for the evening and the Midnight Sun.

**June 21**      **Haines, AK (B)**

We travel along Kluane Lake, the St. Elias Mountains and **Kluane National Park**. From Haines Junction we travel south to the coast through an “alps-like” terrain to Haines for the night.

**June 22**      **Skagway, AK (B)**

**Sailing through the inside passage** we arrive at **Skagway** where gold miners began their trek to the Klondike. Spend the afternoon exploring the shops and historic sites.

**June 23**      **Watson Lake, YT (B, L)**

The **White Pass & Yukon Railway** brings history alive with colourful narration of gold rush tales and incomparable scenery. The narrow-gauge rail winds along the mountains and past steep ravines to the top of the pass. Following an **included lunch at Carcross** we continue to Watson Lake where we explore the famed **Sign-Post Forest**. Here, thousands of signs reflect the many travellers who have made their way along this historic route.

**June 24**      **Stewart, BC (B)**

The **Cassiar Highway** takes us back to British Columbia. Glaciers and waterfalls line a most scenic drive to Stewart.

**June 25**      **Prince George, BC (B)**

We join the Yellowhead Highway, continuing to Prince George.

## June 26 Three Valley Gap, BC (B, D)

Following the Cariboo Route, we travel via Williams Lake and Kamloops to a resort situated on the shores of a pristine mountain lake. An evening **barbecue** in the **Ghost Town**, is a chance to reflect on a fabulous journey to the north.

## June 27 Brooks, AB (B)

Climbing over Rogers Pass, a stop is planned at the **Natural Bridge** and **Canmore** before exiting the Rockies. We bid a fond farewell to some of our group today.
