### August 09 Brooks, AB to Regina, SK

Boarding our luxury motor coach, we begin our journey to Manitoba's Capital City – Winnipeg. A stop is planned at Maple Creek to visit **Grotto Gardens**. Explore the gardens, gift shop and petting zoo and enjoy a morning **coffee break** including a **prairie- sweet-treat**.

### August 10 Winnipeg, MB (B)

Saskatchewan passengers join the tour today. Before departing Regina, a stop is planned to stroll through the **Queen Elizabeth II Gardens** at the Saskatchewan Legislative Buildings. Making our way east, we arrive in Winnipeg for a **four-night stay** at the **Club Regent** Hotel and Casino complex.

### August 11 Winnipeg, MB (B)

A **local guide** joins us this morning to **tour** this culturally diverse city. From the “Golden Boy” atop the provincial legislature to the St. Boniface Cathedral, there are many sights to see. A lunch break and shopping time is planned at **The Forks Market**. As a meeting place for indigenous peoples for over 6,000 years, the Forks is located at the confluence of the Red and Assiniboine Rivers. The area has been transformed to include great dining and shopping options. This afternoon is spent exploring the **Manitoba Museum** which portrays the province's rich and vibrant history. A show in the **planetarium** is also included.

### August 12 Winnipeg, MB (B, L)

Our day begins with a visit to the **Royal Canadian Mint**. A **guided tour** highlights the production of every Canadian circulation coin, as well as circulation coins for countries

around the world. A short drive finds us on the shores of **Lake Winnipeg**. A visit to **Grand Beach** offers a great expanse of sandy beach to stroll and a **picnic lunch** is planned for this relaxing excursion.

### August 13 Winnipeg, MB (B)

Recognized as “Garden of the Year”, the **Leaf Conservatory** is a mosaic of colour, texture and fragrance of four distinct zones. Make a friend with a butterfly in this tropical oasis and explore the extensive exterior gardens at your leisure. The afternoon is planned for a self-guided visit to the **Assiniboine Park Zoo** – one of the nation's finest. Here you will find the **Churchill Exhibit** where polar bears swim freely around the spectator's glass tunnel.

### August 14 Moose Jaw (B)

A return to Saskatchewan sees the departure of some of our group. On arrival in Moose Jaw, we settle in at the **Temple Gardens Mineral Spa** for the night. Enjoy included access to the pools while staying at this lovely hotel. Situated in the heart of the city, you may choose to stroll downtown to a local restaurant or go for an evening walk through Crescent Park.

### August 15 Brooks, AB (B)

Before departing the “Notorious City” we will visit the **Tunnels of Moose Jaw**. Step back to 1929 on the “**Chicago Connection**” **tour** when bootleggers from the Capone organization made the rules. This fun interactive adventure takes you into the famous or “infamous” tunnels. Our journey concludes on arrival in Brooks.

**Departure Points:** You may depart from any location along the first day of travel. Please discuss your options when making your reservation.

**Deposit:** A non-refundable deposit of \$300 per person is required at time of booking. Your booking is **NOT** confirmed without this deposit. Should you need to cancel, this deposit will be retained. Travel Insurance is strongly encouraged. In the unlikely event Corben Tours needs to cancel, all deposits will be returned in full.

**Forms of Payment:** In an effort to reduce overhead costs for our guests, forms of payment include Cheque, Certified Cheque (payable to Corben Tours), Cash or E-transfer ([cbconsult@myaccess.ca](mailto:cbconsult@myaccess.ca)).

\* In the event of the devaluation of the Canadian Dollar, all tours are subject to surcharge until 60 days prior to departure.

**Final Payment:** Due 60 days prior to departure. Bookings made after this date require full payment by certified cheque or e-transfer at time of booking.
