Sept. 06 Brooks, AB to Estevan, SK

Put your cares behind you as we begin our journey to the **Carolina's and Nashville**. Our first overnight is spent in the border city of Estevan.

Sept. 07 Fargo, ND (B)

Today we enter the United States and travel through North Dakota for an overnight in Fargo.

Sept. 08 Iowa City, IA (B)

Travelling via the Twin Cities, we continue south through rich farmlands to Iowa City.

Sept. 09 Indianapolis, IN (B)

After a short drive to Moline, IL we stop to visit the **John Deere Pavilion**. This museum features new and vintage equipment, interactive and immersive exhibits.

Sept. 10 Lexington, KY (B)

This morning, we visit the **Indianapolis Motor Speedway** – home of the “500”. Included is the **Hall of Fame and Museum** where exhibits focus on racing history, and the **track tour** takes us across the finish line. Horse pastures line the roadway as we near Lexington.

Sept. 11, 12 Pigeon Forge, TN (B x 2, D)

Blue grass and white rail fences, this beautiful country is home to some of the finest horse ranches in the world. A **local guide** takes us down back roads of **horse country** and we visit “**Old Friends**” to meet some champions. Nestled in the heart of the Smokey Mountains is Pigeon Forge. Cheer on your favourite riders and enjoy a mouth-watering feast at **Dolly Parton's Stampede Dinner Show**. **Dollywood** is one of America's most popular theme parks. Adorned in everything autumn, take in the numerous shows, explore the shops and of course try some of the local favourite foods.

Sept. 13 Asheville, NC (B, D)

A short drive through beautiful Smokey Mountain scenery guides us to Asheville for a tour of the **Biltmore Estate**. Surrounded by 12,000 acres, this 250 room French Renaissance style home is spectacular in its size, collection of antique furnishings, art-work and 40 acres of gardens.

Sept. 14 Myrtle Beach, SC - 2 Nights (B, D)

Winding our way to the Atlantic we arrive in **Myrtle Beach** for a **two- night-stay – oceanfront**. Be transported to the islands with an exciting **dinner and show at Polynesian Fire**.

Sept. 15 Myrtle Beach, SC (B)

This morning we visit the shopping, dining and entertainment complex of **Broadway at the Beach**. A **free afternoon** is planned for strolling along the beach or just kicking back and relaxing as the waves crashing in to shore.

Sept. 16 Savannah, GA (B, D)

We arrive in historic **Charleston** for a **city tour** of this 300-year-old city and visit **City Market**. Here preservation is a way of life with ante-bellum homes in rainbow hues and fanciful wrought iron work. We continue to Savannah – Georgia's “City of Charm”. A **dinner of traditional southern fare** is served at the 250-year-old **Pirate's House** – one of Savannah's oldest buildings.

Sept. 17 Atlanta, GA – 2 Nights (B)

A morning **trolley tour** travels past town squares, handsome townhouses, fountains, statues and spectacular gardens. Our day concludes in the state capital – Atlanta.

Sept. 18 Atlanta, GA (B)

Depicted in “Gone With The Wind”, this city is rich in history and vibrant with industry. A **local guide** joins us for the morning. The afternoon is spent at **The World of Coca Cola**. Travel through time as you learn about Coca-Cola's history, put your nose to the test in Scent Discovery and sample beverages from around the world.

Sept. 19 Nashville, TN – 3 Nights (B)

“Pardon Me Boys”... yes it is the **Chatanooga Choo Choo**. We travel by **Incline Railway** to the top of **Lookout Mountain** and then visit the famous railroad immortalized in song. Music City here we come. After checking in to the opulent **Opryland Hotel**, we “gear up” for an evening performance at **The Grand Ole Opry**.

Sept. 20 Nashville, TN (B)

Our **locally guided tour** features the many stars and landmarks that have made this city famous. This afternoon, step into the

halls of the many who have dedicated their lives to country music at **The Country Music Hall of Fame**.

Sept. 21 Nashville, TN (B)

Take a stroll down Broadway exploring the many clubs, tour the historic Ryman or relax in the acres of indoor gardens at the hotel. Today is a **free day** for you to do as you choose.

Sept. 22 St. Louis, MO (B)

On arrival in St. Louis we take a ride to the top of the 630-foot **Gateway Arch** where you look down upon the city and the busy Mississippi River below. Featuring six themed exhibit areas, the interactive **museum** celebrates America's pioneering spirit. Trace the story of the Native Americans, explorers, pioneers, and rebels who made America possible.

Sept. 23 Council Bluffs, IA (B)

Travelling via Kansas City, we continue along the Missouri River to Council Bluffs.

Sept. 24 Jamestown, ND (B, DS)

Continuing through the Dakotas, a stop is made to view the **falls at Sioux Falls**. We gather for a **dessert social** this evening.

Sept. 25 Moose Jaw, SK (B)

We stop at Duty Free and to clear customs as we return home to Canada. On arrival in Moose Jaw, soak in the therapeutic waters of **Temple Gardens Mineral Spa** or try your luck in the casino.

Departure Points: You may depart from any location along the first day of travel. Please discuss your options when making your reservation.

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300 per person is required at time of booking. Your booking is **NOT** confirmed without this deposit. Should you need to cancel, this deposit will be retained. Travel Insurance is strongly encouraged. In the unlikely event Corben Tours needs to cancel, all deposits will be returned in full.

Forms of Payment: In an effort to reduce overhead costs for our guests, forms of payment include Cheque, Certified Cheque (payable to Corben Tours), Cash or E-transfer (cbconsult@myaccess.ca).

* In the event of the devaluation of the Canadian Dollar, all tours are subject to surcharge until 60 days prior to departure.

Final Payment: Due 60 days prior to departure. Bookings made after this date require full payment by certified cheque or e-transfer at time of booking.
